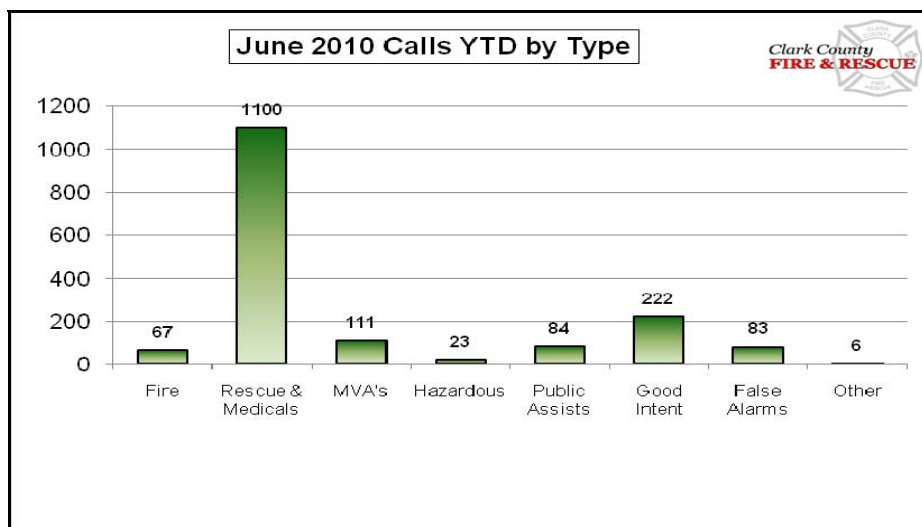


CLARK COUNTY FIRE & RESCUE OPERATIONS REPORT – JUNE 2010



Response Information – 241 Total Responses for June 2010, 1696 YTD Responses

Overall, CCF&R responded to **241** separate calls during the month of June **2010**. These calls included fire (**9**), rescue and medicals (**144**), motor vehicle accidents (**17**), hazardous situations (**3**), public assists (**11**), good intent (**44**), false alarms (**11**), other (**2**).

Comparing the same time period in **2009**, there was a total of **309** calls, which is a decrease of 68 calls between 2010 and 2009. The number of calls by type was most different between years (year-to-date) for rescue and medicals (up to 1100 from 1092), MVA's (down to 111 from 139), fire (down to 67 from 77), public assists (down to 84 from 98), and good intent calls (up to 222 from 211). A year-to-date comparison (YTD 2010 vs. YTD 2009) reveals a decrease in calls to 1696 from 1763.

The majority of June 2010 calls were responded to by **Station 27** with 137 calls, followed by **Station 26** with 27 calls and **Station 23** with 26 calls. The number of calls by other staffed stations ranged from 5 to 21 calls.

The majority of the responses were made by **E27** (82 unit responses), **R27** (69 unit responses), and **E21** (40 unit responses). (R27 calls do not include any by AMR.)

General Response Statistics

During June 2010, the Cities of **Battle Ground** had **124** calls (103 calls in June 2009), **La Center 13** (17 calls in 2009), **Ridgefield 19** calls (50 in 2009), and the **outlying** response area **85** calls (109 in 2009).

According to the Standard of Cover, 90% of Urban Calls should be made within six minutes, 90% of Suburban Calls should be made within eight minutes, and 90% of Rural Calls should be made within ten minutes. As of YTD June 2010, CCF&R was at 86.3% for Urban Calls, 82.3% for Suburban Calls, and 83% for Rural Calls. Individual station percentages are also calculated and enclosed.

"A" shift responded to the most calls with **90**, **"B"** shift responded to **72**, and **"C"** shift **79**. Year-to-date "A" shift has the most number of calls (A =606, B =537, and C =553).

During June 2010, CCF&R received **2 mutual aid responses** and gave **3 mutual aid responses**.
