**PROCEDURE:**

- No horseplay will be tolerated.
- Everyone will be present at the safety briefings.
- Point out any potential safety concern to an instructor or your company officer. If safe to do so, remove the safety hazard.
- Hand tools will be carried as outlined in the current cadet program textbook.
- Call out a safety stop if you see an act you deem unsafe.
- Do not run while in the apparatus bay. Any time that you are in the apparatus bay you must be aware of your surroundings. Failure to do so could result in serious injury.
- Drink plenty of water.
