



**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PETITION OF CLARK COUNTY
FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 2 TO MERGE THE DISTRICT
INTO CLARK COUNTY FIRE & RESCUE**


WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioner of Clark County Fire Protection District No. 2 (District 2) have presented a Petition to the Board of Commissioners of Clark County Fire & Rescue (CCF&R) to merge District 2 into CCF&R; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of CCF&R has reviewed the petition and finds it is in the best interest of both Districts that District 2 be merged into and become a part of CCF&R; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has reviewed and studied the proposal and has considered the Environmental Checklist prepared by staff provided for under WAC 197-11-960.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Clark County Fire & Rescue accepts the Petition for Merger; declares itself lead agency for SEPA review; finds that such merger will not significantly affect the environment; and, therefore, hereby adopts the attached final Declaration of Nonsignificance and authorizes and direct the secretary to transmit the Petition together with a copy of this Resolution to Clark County Fire Protection District No. 2.
